

Codecs for MediaShout

To fix many of the codec related issues in MediaShout (v3.x and v4.x), we recommend the K-Lite Mega Codec Pack. This codec pack contains DVD codecs as well as MP4 support.

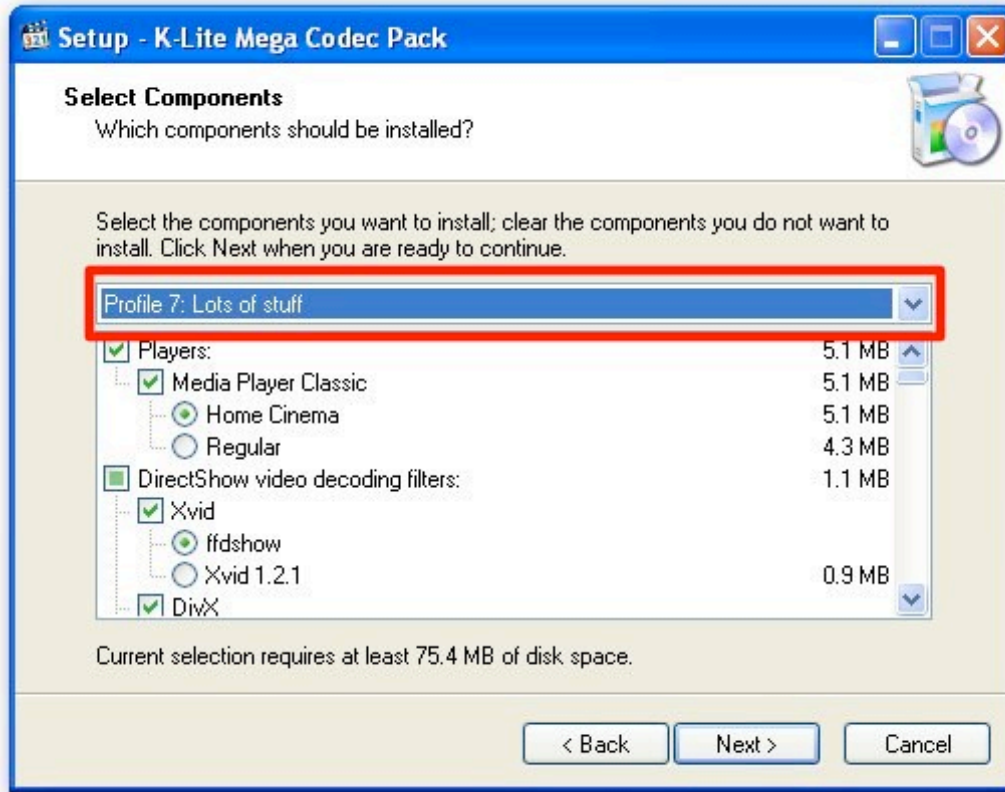


You will be prompted to either Run or Save the file. If you select **Run**, the installer will download and launch automatically. If you choose **Save**, you will have to select a location to download the installer file to. Usually the desktop is the best location for this. If you chose to save the file, locate the installer file and double-click it to launch the setup utility after it downloads.

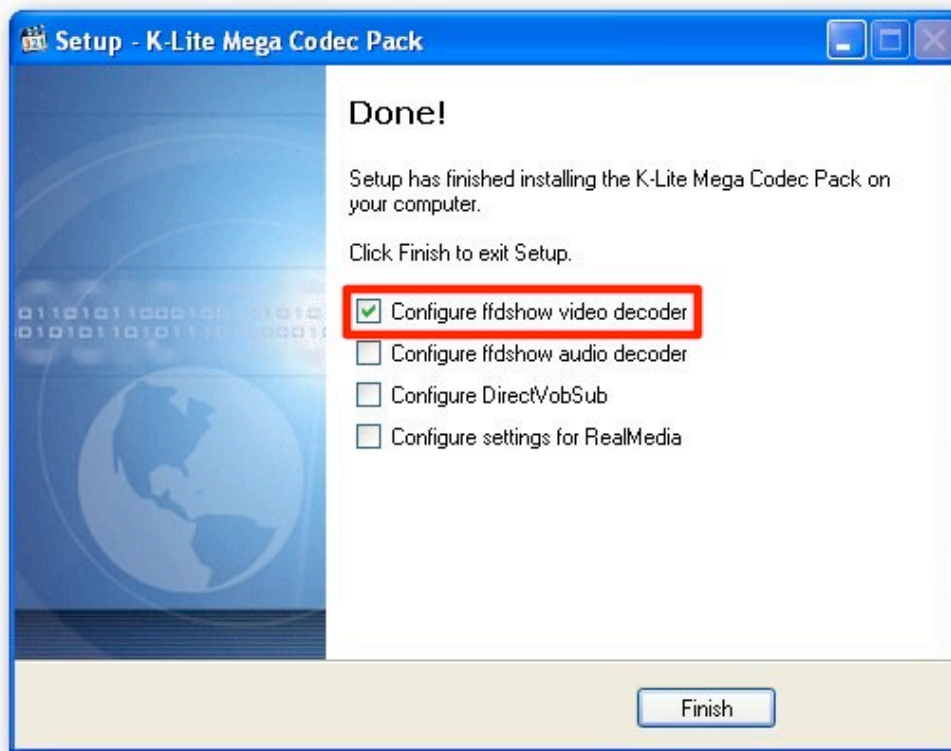
After you've launched the K-Lite setup utility, you are going to see two screens. Click **Next** on each of these.

When you get to the third screen, allow K-Lite to be installed in the default location.

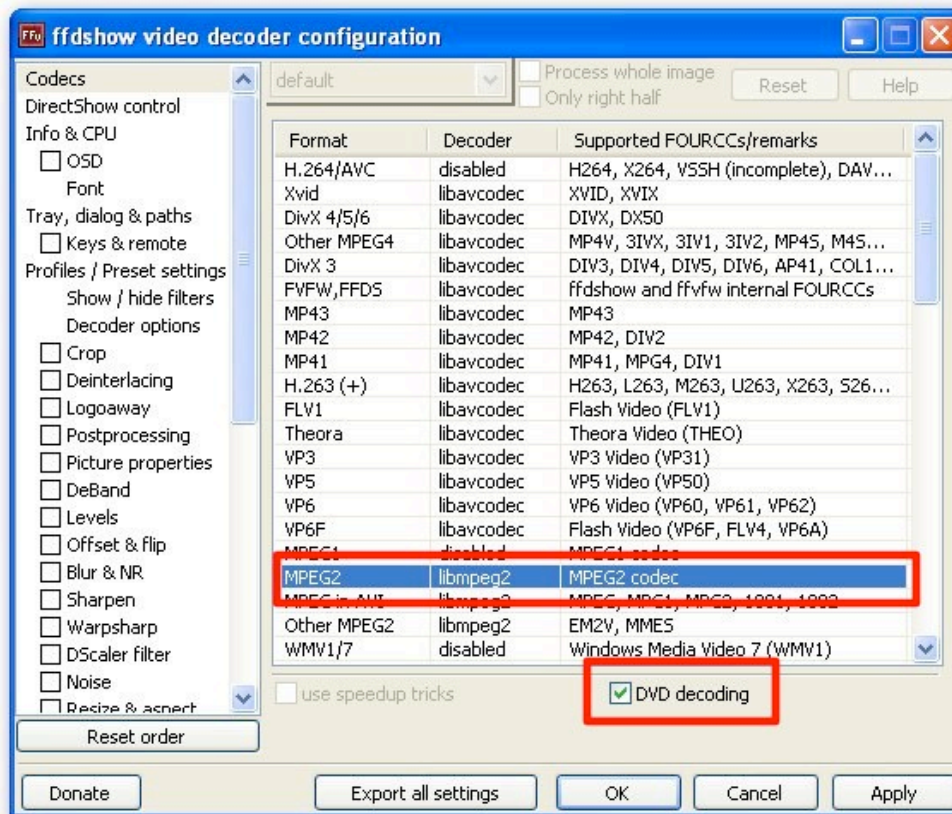
At the fourth screen you are going to be asked to select which profile you want to install. Click on the drop down arrow and select **Profile 7: Lots of stuff** then click **Next**.



Click **Next** on the next few screens until you get to this one:



Then click on **Finish** which will now launch the **ffdshow video decoder configuration**.



Click on **Codecs** in the left hand column. Click on **MPEG2** from the list on the right. The second column will say **disabled** by default. Click on that and select **libmpeg2** from the list. Check the box that says **DVD decoding**. Click **Apply** and **OK**.

Test your videos or DVDs in MediaShout again.
